


Searching for Audiobooks Help Sheet

Note: In order to download Audiobooks and transfer them to a portable device, you must first download the Audiobooks on EBSCOhost Download Manager software. You will be prompted to install the software the first time you download an Audiobook.

The default search screen for Audiobooks on EBSCOhost is basic search. The Audiobook Collection screen displayed below is available by clicking the **Audiobooks** link in the top toolbar.

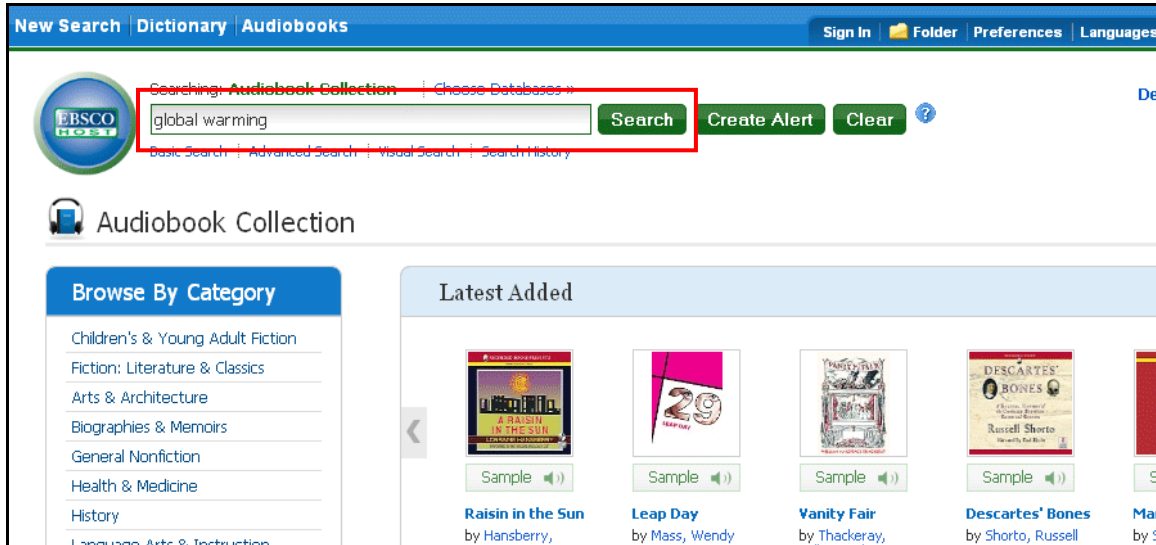


There are several ways to search for Audiobooks on EBSCOhost:

- Perform a keyword search of the Audiobooks database using the **Find** field.
- **Browse by Category** by selecting a category from the column on the left.
- View the **Latest Added** Audiobooks using the left and right arrows or click **View All** to view a result list of all latest added Audiobooks.
- View **Featured Audiobooks** using the left and right arrows to change categories or click **View All** to view a result list of all Featured Audiobooks.

To search for Audiobooks on EBSCOhost:

1. Enter your search terms in the **Find** field and click **Search**.



2. A result list of Audiobooks is displayed.



3. Click the **Sample** button to hear a preview of the Audiobook.
4. Click the **Download** link to download the Audiobook and transfer it to a portable device.

Downloading an Audiobook

Once you have selected an Audiobook to download, you can download it and transfer it to a portable device using Windows Media Player or iTunes.

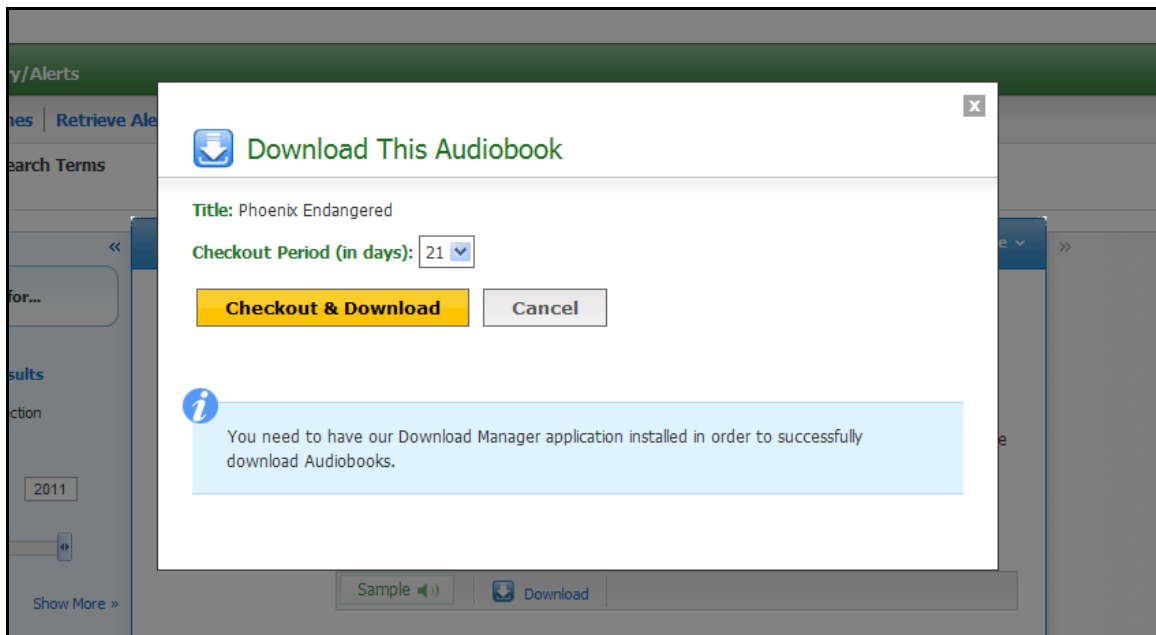
To download Audiobooks:

1. From the result list, click the **Download** link to download the Audiobook.

Note: If you have not downloaded the Audiobook Download Manager software, you will be prompted to do so.

If you are not already signed in to your My EBSCOhost folder, you will be prompted to do so.

2. Select a **Checkout Period** from the drop-down menu and click **Checkout and Download**.



The Audiobook is added to the **Checkouts** area of the folder and the Download Manager software should automatically begin to download the Audiobook to your computer.

3. If the download does not start automatically, click the **Download** link for your checked-out Audiobook from the **Checkouts** area of the folder.
4. Depending on your device preference, the Download Manager transfers your Audiobook to a connected Apple device or to Windows Media Player.

You can transfer the Audiobook to a non-Apple device using Windows Media Player.
