Notes regarding Intention to undertake Demolition Works

- 1. Notice must be given to the Local Authority where it is intended to demolish the whole or part of a building except:-
 - A demolition in pursuance of a demolition order made under the Housing Act 1957, and
 - Demolition:-

i. of an internal part of a building, where the building is occupied and it is intended that it should remain occupied.

ii. of a building that has a cubic content (as ascertained by external measurement) of not more than 1750 cubic feet, or, where a greenhouse, conservatory, shed or prefabricated garage, or iii. without prejudice to sub-paragraph (ii) above, of an agricultural building, (as defined in section 26 of the General Rate Act 1967), unless it is contiguous to another building of a kind mentioned in that sub-paragraph.

- 2. It is the duty of the person giving the notice to send or give a copy of the notice to:
 - a) The occupier of any building adjacent to the building
 - b) The Gas Utility : Transco
 - c) Electricity supplier.
 - d) Water supplier
- 3. Unless planning permission has already been granted for the redevelopment of the site, including this proposed demolition, the developer shall, before beginning the development, apply to the local planning authority for a determination as to whether the prior approval of the authority will be required to the method of demolition and any proposed restoration of the site. - 4. One copy of this form is required, together with one copy of a site plan to identify the land (preferably to a scale of 1:1250 and with the site outlined in red).
- 5. A person who fails to carry out the requirements of Section 80 of the Building Act 1980 is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 4 on the standard scale.
- 6. All demolition work is subject to the Construction (Design & Management) Regulations 1994. It is the responsibility of the Client and Contractor to ensure that all requirements of these regulations are met and the Health and Safety Executive notified where appropriate.
