

## What to do if you have a case of COVID-19 in your school

1 CHILD OR STAFF MEMBER WHO HAS SYMPTOMS of

New continuous cough
Temperature

Change in sense of smell or taste

1 CHILD OR STAFF MEMBER WHO TESTS POSITIVE

2 OR MORE CHILDREN OR STAFF WHO TEST POSITIVE or increase in absences where COVID-19 suspected IF the CHILD is in the setting – Isolate away from others until they can be picked up from school.

(Refer to PPE guidance on gov.uk if personal care is required within 2m)

If a staff member, they should go home immediately.

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Individual goes home to self-isolate for 7 days since onset of symptoms and get tested via NHS online or calling 119.

Household contacts of case self-isolate for 14 days.

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No need to notify PHE Health Protection Team.

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Other important control measures to reduce risk to other children and staff include: minimising contact with those who are unwell, handwashing, respiratory hygiene, cleaning, minimising mixing and contact by altering the environment and daily schedules.
