Section 5.0, Movement and Transport. Overall, I believe the plan has some good proposals (particularly around new developments) but I remain dissappointed that, although parking was raised by the residents as a major issue, there are no significant improvements proposed in the plan which will make a difference to residents. I note that there are restrictions by RMBC but if Wickersley Council is serious about representing its residents you have a duty to make protestations to RMBC and find some opportunties to make improvements wherever possible. Yes, encouragement to walk and cycle more is a fine aspiration and, as leisure activities, will probably increase but I cannot envisage that the car will be replaced as the primary means of transport. Years of cycle lanes have not changed the habits of most people!
