

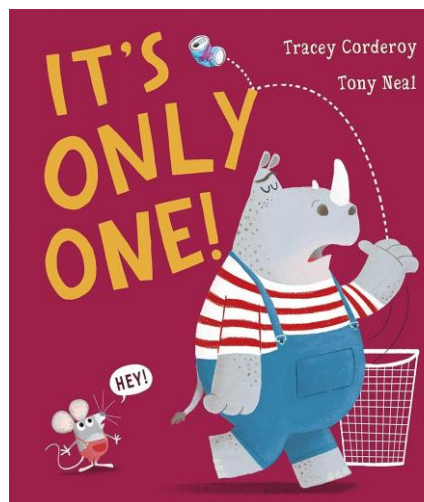
Specific Areas of Learning
