

Referendum on the United Kingdom's membership of the European Union

Thursday 23 June 2016

Notice of Referendum Rotherham voting area

1. A referendum will be held on **Thursday 23 June 2016** to decide on the question below:
Should the United Kingdom remain a member of the European Union or leave the European Union?
2. The hours of poll will be from **7am to 10pm**.
3. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **12 midnight on Tuesday 7 June 2016**. Applications can be made online: www.gov.uk/register-to-vote.
4. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Riverside House, Main Street, Rotherham, S60 1AE by **5pm on Wednesday 8 June 2016**.
5. New applications to vote by proxy must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Riverside House, Main Street, Rotherham, S60 1AE by **5pm on Wednesday 15 June 2016**. Requests for changes to existing proxy vote arrangements and cancellations must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **5pm on Wednesday 8 June 2016**.
6. Applications to vote by emergency proxy on the grounds of disability or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Riverside House, Main Street, Rotherham, S60 1AE by **5pm on Thursday 23 June 2016**. The disability must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday 15 June 2016. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Wednesday 15 June 2016.
