Prime Areas of Learning

COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

- Sing Twinkle, Twinkle Little Star [Twinkle Twinkle Little Star - YouTube](#)
- Explore the rhyming words in the story. Can we continue a rhyming string for star, pet, shine?
- Talk about the describing words in the story. Do we know what they mean e.g. bumped, tumbled, scratched?
- Add bedroom resources to the doll's house.



PSED

- Circle time - Talk about how we care for others. What kind things can we do to make people feel happy and safe?
- Go star gazing at night. Can you find the brightest star?
- Turn the home corner into a bedroom adding in hot water bottles, bedtime stories, pyjamas etc. Talk about the night-time routine using sequencing words.
- Circle Time – Talk about how the star made the girl feel e.g. happy and joy. What makes you feel like this?
- Circle Time – Talk about how the little girl might have felt when the star returned to the night sky? E.g. lonely, sad, scared.
