


## Book 6 (2's and Under) Getting Ready by Cocoretto

### Prime Areas of Learning

#### COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

- Names the items of clothing to the children when putting on the children's clothes to go outdoors, home.
- Make a teddy bears picnic at snack time, what does teddy like to eat?
- Gather a selection of socks in a basket, can the children look and match the patterns together.
- Sing songs together with the actions, this little piggy went to market, this is the way we get dressed (to mulberry brush tune).



#### PSED

- Set up a teddy with the cup, bowl and spoon, model feeding the teddy, having a drink, yummy.
- Have a small bed for teddy to sleep in with a blanket to cover him up.
- Make a brush treasure basket, a variety of brushes to explore, hairbrush, nail, pastry, scrubbing, shaving, large paint brushes. **(Always use with adult input & risk assess)**
- Make a shoe basket with a variety of small shoes to try on, red wellies, pumps, glittery shoes.
- Use simple cards with items of clothing, look at them together.

#### PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

- Make a zip board, a piece of thin wood or thick cardboard, glue a variety of zips onto the board for the children to open and close.
- Get a large cardboard box with both ends open, make holes in the top and hang socks at different lengths for the children to crawl through.
- Put on the wellies and go for a stomp outdoors, can you find any muddy puddles?
- Hide teddy outdoors, can the children find him? Where could he be? Up a tree, in a bush? Riding a bike?
