The recent flooding in the Laughton area has again demonstrated the devastating impact on existing houses when new housing development is undertaken on surrounding field areas. The 243 houses will likely have a significant impact on the run off of water in the local residential area and put thousands of homes at risk of flooding - this is unacceptable.

Further consideration also needs to be given in light of the closure of the local RotherValley college too and the impact this will have on the needs of the local area - as the plan is effectively out of date. There are priorities that need adressing in the local area before we start building new houses that will cause more problems for existing residents.
